



Chile– USM/UC/PUC

In partnership with Inria Chile, Inria has signed three mobility agreements with prestigious Chilean universities:

- La Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile (in 2017)
- L'Universidad de Chile (in 2018)
- L'Universidad Técnica Federico Santa María (in 2018)

These agreements allow Inria teams to welcome students in the final year of engineering studies for three-month research internships, usually from January to March every year.

Every year, calls for applications are published by partner universities participating in the programme.

United States – Châteaubriand

Inria is a partner of the Chateaubriand fellowship programme run by the Office for Science & Technology (OST) of the Embassy of France in the United States, which allows PhD students enrolled at American universities to conduct research at a French laboratory for a period ranging from 4 to 6 months.

A call for applications is posted on the [programme website](#) every year.

Canada-MITACS

The partnership between Inria and MITACS (National Canadian Network of Centres of Excellence in Mathematics and in Information Technology and Complex Systems) was renewed in late 2018.

The Inria-MITACS exchange programmes give graduate students at Canadian universities and PhD students from Inria research teams the opportunity to carry out 16- to 24-week research projects in France and Canada, respectively.

The projects are jointly supervised by faculty members at Canadian universities and researchers at Inria Research Centres.

French PhD students from Inria project-teams who wish to take part in a research exchange in Canada must submit an internal request to Inria and contact the international correspondents from their Centre, who will help them submit their application.

Canadian students (master's or PhD level) who wish to complete an internship within an Inria project team must submit applications directly on the [MITACS Globalink platform](#).

South America

STIC AmSud and MATH AmSud are two France-South America cooperation programmes in the fields of information sciences and technology, and mathematics, respectively.

These regional programmes aim to foster and strengthen collaboration and networking in research and development.

These two-year projects must have a regional focus with the participation of one or more French teams and at least two research teams from two participating South American countries.

Following the selection of projects, funding allows for researcher mobility and for holding meetings and joint scientific events.

- Inria supports between 3 and 6 projects per year
- Participating countries: Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Ecuador, France (Inria, CNRS), Peru, Paraguay, Uruguay and Venezuela.
